## The Old Central School

Seen at upper left, this school was built c. 1867 on the site of the St. Joseph's Catholic Church Hall (formerly the Masonic Temple), in accordance with the new Free Schools Act. The cupola-crowned building, usually referred to as the Central School burned circa 1917, having been replaced by the new Academy on Queen Street in 1914-1915.
